Do you offer medical services on Orcas island? If so, where? If so, what kind of services?

Yes. The clinic is located at 97 Yellow Brick Road, Eastsound.

As a local primary care physician, I have seen and treated patients with a variety of diagnoses including influenza, strep throat, pneumonia, otitis media, cellulitis, urinary tract infection, prostate hypertrophy, prostate and breast cancers, ulcerative colitis, irritable bowel syndrome, anemia, GERD, migraine headache, Parkinson disease, stroke, muscular weakness, metabolic syndrome/Diabetes, hyperlipidemia, chronic fatigue syndrome, depression, anxiety, insomnia, CHF (weakening heart), atrial fibrillation, cardiac arrhythmia, valvular heart diseases, sleep apnea, hypertension, shoulder, elbow and/or knee pain, sciatica/Piriformis syndrome, aseptic necrosis of hip from chronic steroid usage and plantar fasciitis

I have offered nutritional counseling (foods as medicines), chronic/acute pain management, preventive medicine, evidence-based herbs/supplements, acupuncture, Qi-Gong/Tai-Chi for stress management and educational seminars as well as blood draws.

I have been providing home care visits for patients who have become incapacitated.

Do you accept insurance?

Due to the lack of the funding, the clinic is unable to hire a medical insurance biller; therefore, the patients pay cash on the basis of the sliding scale. The sliding scale works on a law of averages; some pay more so that others can pay less, and it all averages out. If those who have the financial means to contribute above the average do so, it helps us to provide services to those with lower incomes. Our goal is to make the healthcare accessible to everyone, regardless of economic class.

Unfortunately, a majority of patients paid the lowest level on the scales (or are unable to pay). Our Board filed 990-EZ in 2016 to the IRS. Our program services (gross) revenue was \$24,214. Our operating expense was \$20,862, plus a monthly loan payment of \$908, payable to Professional Financial Services Solutions. I haven't received any salary in 2017 and 2018.

I am concerned about the financial challenge associated with my medical practice on Orcas Island. Our Board initiates a fundraising letter which is an

appeal to help solve a financial dilemma that we have faced since the inception of our clinic.

Are you interested in offering your services through one of the existing clinics?

Yes, I have been applying for a job at UW Medicine since 05/2017. I am in contact with the Provider Relations Manager for UW Medicine. I have done a couple of phone interviews and exchanged multiple emails.
